Format: Five invitation-only 10-player Round Robins by rating: Championship, Premier, Invitational, Challengers, and Rising Stars. The field of each section will be determined by seeding and by the highest rated players to register based on the highest (January 31st Northwest, January US Chess Regular supplement, or January FIDE rating). All sections will be Northwest, US Chess, and FIDE Tri-rated.

Time Control: 40/120; SD/30; +10. Late default: 60 minutes, (except for Rd. 1).

Entry Fee/Deposit:

Championship/Premier: Free, with deposit. Invitational/Challengers/Rising Stars: \$150. **Note:** For Championship and Premier, a \$450 deposit via check, Zelle, or SettleKing before the start of round 1 is required, to be refunded upon successful completion of all 9 rounds.

Schedule: Mandatory Check-in: 9:45am on 2/10 before the start of rd. 1. Rds. 1-8: Feb. 10, 11, 17, 18 @ 10 AM and 5 PM. Rd. 9: Feb. 19 (President's Day) @ 5 PM. Drawing of lots: Feb. 3 @ 10 PM at the Orlov Academy in Greenlake. Attendance is optional, though encouraged.

Prizes: The initial prize fund for each section is guaranteed by the WCF and will be increased based on donations.

<u>Championship:</u> \$1500, <u>Premier:</u> \$1250, <u>Invitational:</u> \$1000, <u>Challengers:</u> \$750, <u>Rising Stars:</u> \$500.

Prize distribution (each section): 1st 45%, 2nd 25%, 3rd 15%, 4th 10%, 5th 5% Best Annotated Game Prizes: \$500 (\$100 for best annotated game in each section)

The winner of the Championship section receives the title of WA State Champion.

Byes: Since this is a prestigious round robin, there will be **no byes or rescheduling of games allowed in any of the sections**. All games must be played on site under TD supervision at the scheduled round times. Players who drop out of the event will be ineligible to play for the next two years and will forfeit their entry fee/deposit/prize.

Eligibility: Open to all WA State residents who have resided in WA for the past 6 months and meet the two-event activity requirement over the course of 2023.
