**John Cerminaro, French horn**

Long considered one of the most colorful fixtures on the classical music scene, John Cerminaro has played solo horn with the New York and Los Angeles Philharmonic orchestras under Leonard Bernstein and Carlo Maria Giulini, and taught at the Aspen Music Festival and the California Institute for the Arts. He is widely known for his recording work, ranging from the four Mozart horn concertos to John William's score for the *NBC Nightly News*. Author of *The Greater Glory*, a treatise for performers, Mr. Cerminaro was the Landsdowne Lecturer at Victoria College, taught "The Business of Music" weekly at the Juilliard School, and has been the Seattle Symphony's principal horn for the past ten years.
