Kayden Troff is a chess grandmaster who was born and raised in Utah. He learned chess when he was three years old from watching his dad and two older brothers play. Growing up, they played together, which led to many tournament victories and a competitive spirit among the brothers. This included many teaching opportunities, like running a summer chess camp with another chess family for seven years. Eventually, Kayden's brothers moved on to other things while Kayden continued to pursue chess. Chess tournament achievements:

- 1st place 2009 U12 North American Youth Championship in Mazatlán, Mexico.
- 2nd place 2010 World Youth Championships, Under-12 section.
- 1st place 2012 World Youth Championships, Under-14 section.
- 1st place 2014 Under-21 U.S. Chess Champion
- Achieved the title of Grandmaster at age 16, becoming Utah's first home-grown GM!

Kayden has been coaching privately and in groups for 10+ years and spends much of his time streaming chess with Antonio Padron on Twitch under ChessSharkz.
