Format: Five Scheveningen-style matches, in which teams of 5 adults (Kings/Queens) will play against teams of 5 juniors (Princes/Princesses). Each player will face one of the opposing team members once over the course of 5 rounds. All games will be dual US Chess and FIDE rated. The aim of these events is to increase the number of Northwest players with established FIDE ratings and to support local junior players seeking experience in preparation for World Youth Competitions.

Sections: March 2018 US Chess rating supplement will be used to determine pairings and section.
