

## RUSSELL'S CHESS CHATS

Grandmaster David Bronstein said of the world challenger Boris Spassky "In the last few years Spassky has grown into a substantial personality in the chess world. His great erudition, scope of views, and splendid skill in all phases of the game enable him to produce masterpieces. He has inherited Steinitz depth of strategic scheming and fearlessness in all circumstances, Rubinstein's subtle skill in the endgame, Capablanca's ease and clarity in building up attacking positions, and Smyslov's exceptionally high standards of exploiting the slightest advantage."

Spassky will play a 24 game match with Tigran Petrosian in May to decide the World Championship. Spassky will also play in the Hastings Christmas Congress in England along with Y. Vasyukov (13th in recent USSR Champ) Gligoric (Yugo), Uhlmann (E.Ger), Gheorghiu (Roumania), Pflieger (W.Ger), Nicolai (W.Ger) Lee (British Champion), N. Littlewood and Hartson both of England.

Kavalek (Czek) won a Bulgarian tournament with 11, Kolarov (Bul)  $9\frac{1}{2}$ , Bobotsov, Lensyel and Matulovic 9.

Gligoric, Suetin and Taimanov all scored 11 points to take the International Tourney in Copenhagen, Larsen  $10\frac{1}{2}$ , Hort (Czeck) 10, and Duckstein (Austria) 9 etc.

Larsen & Geller will play a match to determine 3rd and 4th places in the candidates event in Feb or March 1966.

Only slight changes were made in the next cycle of the World Championship after much debate at the last FIDE congress held in late September in Wiesbaden. Zonal tourneys in 1966, Interzonal 1967, Candidates in 1968 and World Championship in 1969. Will Fischer take part??

New International Grandmasters, Shamkovitch and Suetin (USSR), Ciric, Janosevic and Matulovic (Yug) and Gheorghiu (Roumania) and Hort (Czek). (What's in a name now, ed.?!?)

New International Masters Whitaker (USA). Pflieger and Unzicker at 11 pts won the W. German Championship.

Forintos (Hun) won a Swiss tourney at Imperia, Italy.

Diez del Corral won the Spanish Championship with 13 from 15 points. O. Garcia 10, Medina  $9\frac{1}{2}$ . Ulvestad didn't play this year.

According to the Chess Correspondent the official publication of the CCLA, a couple of NW players won their sections of the CCLA specials, Glen Duckendock 6-0, Clark Harmon  $5\frac{1}{2}$ - $\frac{1}{2}$ . NW rated players are Duckendorf 888, Cowan 939, Hainsworth 423, Harmon 865, Miller 500, Frentice 856 and Vandenburg 1068.

James Sherwin won the 105 man Empire City Open in N.Y.  $5\frac{1}{2}$ - $\frac{1}{2}$ . At 5-1 were Roy Hoppe, Larry Kaufman, Paul Brandts, John Familjens, Morton Siegal, Mike Valvo, and Allen Baisley.

Leonard Stein won the Russian Championship just completed, with several well known ones finishing out of the money. More on this in next issue.

Hal Benko won the 122 man American Open in Santa Monica 7-1, Larry Evans, Anthony Saidy drew Benko and each other to place second, at  $6\frac{1}{2}$ - $1\frac{1}{2}$ . Along with them were R. Kirby, I. Rivise and our old friend J. Schmitt. Our old editor "Rock" Schultz has sent us a couple of games and they will be in next issue.

Rd 6 The results of this round were as reported (see games section report) with the exception that Bisguier & Saidy drew.

Rd 7 Addison was ill and did not play. D. Suttles this round. Other results are: Reshevsky - Bisguier (adj) but looks sure for Reshevsky.

Burger-Evans (adj) probable Evans win. Benko-Rossolimo (adj) Benko has advantage. Zuckerman-Byrne drawn.

Rd 8 The 8th round was the lowest quality wise of the tournament. Reshevsky tried to win a drawn endgame when both he and Saidy were in time pressure and he blew it. Suttles-Evans showed Suttles having Evans positionally busted, but instead of consolidating his position before attacking, he attacked right away. Evans coolly defended, got the better game and then Suttles blew a piece. Bisguier had a colorless draw to Burger. Bisguier has 3 draws and five losses in 8 rounds. Saidy is the coolest head in the tournament. He has nerves of steel and doesn't get discouraged by a loss. Rossolimo-Zuckerman (adj) a probable draw. Fischer-Byrne a loss for Dobby. Addison-Benko (adj) looks drawish.

# TOURNAMENT NORTHWEST BY BUDDY

Ladies and gentlemen, the United States Chess Federation, the Washington Chess Federation, and Tournament Northwest are overjoyed to announce that the 1966 United States Open Championship Chess Tournament will be held in SEATTLE!!!!

This is the big one. It will be a two week tournament with registration all day Sunday August 14, and play beginning Monday August 15. The final round will be held on Friday August 26.

This tournament will draw players from the entire country, and there is a good chance that there could be some players up from the international Paitagorsky Cup held immediately preceding this tournament in L. A. But the success of this tournament depends primarily on northwest support.

The local U.S. Open committee is at the moment comprised of your writer as the chairman; CLARK HARMON publicity, and STEVE CHRISTOPHER finance. At the moment we are all engaged in organizing and promoting the 1966 WASHINGTON OPEN, and so will not begin work in earnest on the US Open until late January. There is indeed much work to do between now and next summer, and we will sincerely appreciate all the help we can get.

\* \* \* \*

On the facing page is the write-up of the two one day tournaments held earlier in the month. As you can readily see they can not be considered well attended. We are arriving at the conclusion that off-hand type tournaments do not have a great deal of appeal, and perhaps they are not worth the effort of the WCF to stage. We find that the majority of tournament players feel a week-end devoted to chess should be for serious competition, and that they can find enough off-hand chess at their clubs, or with personal friends. To look back at the record of off-hand tournament attendance for the past two years; we see 1964 30/30 - (8), 1965 NW Speed - (9), 1965 30/30 - (14), and the

two tornados at (8) and (6). We feel that perhaps this type of competition might best be handled on a club level, as the support for this sort of event is not sufficiently wide-spread to warrant WCF sponsorship. On the tournament schedule below, there is already scheduled the 30/30 and Cyclone for 1966. (The Seattle Cyclone will be run in the same manner as the two tornados.) In order to give this type of competition a completely fair opportunity, these events will be conducted, and the final decision in regard to continuation will depend upon there result.

\* \* \* \*

1966 promises to be a booming year for northwest chess. Beginning with the N. W. Invitational which should be the strongest tourney on record in the northwest. This is to be followed closely by the big 1966 WASHINGTON OPEN, which although a week-end event will contain many of the features of a national chess tournament. The response to the arrangements for the open have been encouraging, and we are assured of an extremely large turn out. Then the U.S. Open next summer. Happy 1966 from TNW.

# Pullen Braley Smith VIII

KENT PULLEN, JOHN BRALEY, both of Seattle, and RONALD G. SMITH, of Hoquiam tied for first in the first of the two one day tornados, held Dec. 11 and 12 at the Seattle Chess Club.

Smith lost his first round game to Z. Wester after arriving for the tournament to find only thirty minutes left on his clock to make 40 moves. Smith had registered by telephone from Tacoma.

Top ranked Braley was upset in round one by NADAV FRIEDMAN. Braley found himself

in tight time-pressure with about twenty moves yet to make with less than two minutes remaining. Playing the attack Braley managed to win a queen for a minor piece, but in the ensuing scramble also managed to leave his own queen in take.

In the final round Smith won from K. Pullen, by accepting a gambit pawn in the opening, and holding the pawn advantage to win the end game.

STEPHEN CHRISTOPHER won the tourney class "B" prize, with a  $1\frac{1}{2}$ - $2\frac{1}{2}$  record, and ZACK WESTER won the "C" award with his even 2 - 2 score.

PAT HICKEY, of Seattle, won the second of the one day tornados, with a  $3\frac{1}{2}$  -  $\frac{1}{2}$  record. Hickey yielded only a first rd. draw to second finishing JOHN WALKER, of Bothell.

EDDIE SONIER, of Seattle, finished in third spot with a  $2\frac{1}{2}$ - $1\frac{1}{2}$  result, losing to the tournament winner in the final round. In preparing for his final round game with Hickey, Sonier remembered that Hickey had used the wing gambit to win the woodpusher tournament, and prepared a line against it. To no avail, however, as the game went; 1. P-K4, P-QB4; 2. P-KB4. Another of Pat's

slightly off-beat, but lively lines.

There were no class "C" players in the tournament, so only the single class award for "B" was presented. GERALD STILES won this after John Walker had selected the 2nd place award.

Only Sonier, Smith, and Christopher played in both tournaments, and Sonier had the best combined total at  $4\frac{1}{2}$ - $3\frac{1}{2}$ . Smith 4 - 4, and Christopher  $1\frac{1}{2}$  -  $6\frac{1}{2}$ .

Gerald Stiles established a tournament first, (and last - B.E.), by playing 2 games at once. He found himself in what promised to be a long end game with Christopher, and still had an adjournment with Smith. All parties concerned agreed to the arrangement so Stiles proceeded to play the games simultaneously. He won both.

It would seem that this club is one of the more active clubs around, one which certainly sets a good example for others. One of the sad, but true, facts of life is that a chess club without members willing to work toward improving the club is doomed to stagnation.
