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# 1989 Keres Memorial

May 19-22, 1989

Report by John Braley and Fred Kleist

John Braley:

The Open Section of this year's Paul Keres Memorial Tournament did without some of B.C.'s well known faces. Where were the Browns... Paul, Harold and Alan? What about Harry Moore and Glenn Morin?

Among the 43 participants in the competition was one distinctively new face. Juri Vetemaa, a chess journalist and instructor from Tallin, Estonia, happened to be in town visiting relatives when he chanced upon the B.C. chess scene. His first event was an April Fools tourney (4-0), followed by a strong Vancouver Invitational (8½-½), and an even tougher Northwest Invitational (6-3) where he was tagged for four draws and even lost a game (to Piasetski). These performances are not a flash in the pan, however; Juri has played in the Estonian Championship 13 times, five times finishing in the top three.

Would Juri's solid, alert style carry the Keres? He had three main competitors: IM John Donaldson, IM Leon Piasetski, and FM Tom O'Donnell, who recently made an IM norm. Only Tom lost to Juri (after 1 e4 c5 2 c3 Juri played 2...Qa5 and Tom went silly). John drew quietly. Leon threatened to repeat his previous win but had to settle for a draw.

Unfortunately for the contenders, they bobbled their chances elsewhere. Donaldson missed a stitch vs O'Donnell; Piasetski wrongly decided not to perpetual check against both Braley and O'Donnell. O'Donnell got ambushed by Jeff Reeve.

So Juri won his first five games (Greg Huber, Lionel Joyner, Gary Basanta, Glenn Johnstone, Tom O'Donnell), tucked away two draws (Donaldson, Piasetski), and picked up \$900 Canadian for clear first place (6-1). John Donaldson took clear second and \$600 back to the states. Third place (and combined U2400 prize), \$250, was pocketed by Jeff Reeve, Gary Basanta, and Nigel Fullbrook. Jeff seemed a bit off form but finished strongly, Gary once again found me to be easy last round pickings, and Nigel received an extra \$50 for being the most sportsmanlike and gentlemanly vs the Phoenix computer (and you thought those machines didn't notice such things!). The U2200 prize was won by Francisco Cabanas and Barry Rassmussen. More about these experts later.

Washington players in the Open Section: John Donaldson (5½), John Braley (4), Dan Marshall, Mike Franett, Fred Kleist, Hanniegn Pitre (3½), and Bill McGearry (WD). (Apologies to anyone I overlooked.) For a while Mr. Marshall thought his position in his last round game might be worth a chunk of money (4½ would have been clear first U2200), but he let his opponent (a wily trickster) snap a piece and his hopes. Still an excellent result overall for Dan, since most of his opponents were masters.

This tournament had an abundance of rich strange, entertaining struggles. Even most of the draws were hard fought tangles. But let's start out with a solid performance from the champ.

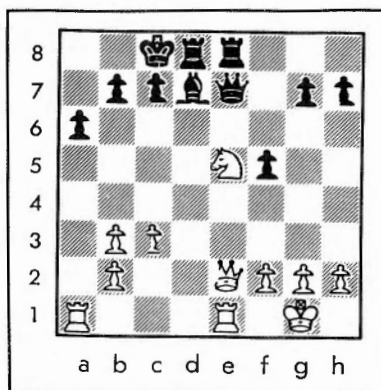

The upshot was a stunning loss to Tom's rejoinder.

# Washington State Kids Succeed in Nationals

The National Elementary Championships were held in Tempe Arizona April 28-30. Over 800 children ranging in age from 5 to 12 participated. Three levels of competition were offered, the Elementary (E) section, which was actually the open section allowed children in grades K (Kindergarten) through 6 (K-6). The Elementary Junior Varsity (EJV) was limited to children whose ratings were below 1200, grades K-6, and finally, the Primary (P) section featured kids in grades K-3 only.

The tournament was held on the campus of Arizona State University at the Activity Center. This arena offered excellent playing conditions. The arena lighting provided levels of illumination which would have pleased even Bobby Fischer. Parents were restricted to the stands which were elevated, and only coaches were allowed on the floor, which considerably reduced potential for sidelines coaching.

Five kids from Washington participated in the tournament with fairly good results. Two of them won awards. The Washington participants were (ranging in age): Kweilin Moore, E section, 6th grade, from Lakeside Middle School, Seattle; Litsun Moore, EJV section, 5th grade, from Seattle Country Day School, Seattle; Paul Doyle, P section, 3rd grade, from Broadview Elementary, Oak Harbor; Peter McCullum 3rd grade, from Broadview Elementary, Oak Harbor; Julia Neuhaus, P section, 2nd grade, from Sacajawea ECEC, Seattle.

Oak Harbor is on Whidbey Island.

Kweilin and Litsun Moore were the only brother-sister participants from Washington, and also had the best results. Litsun scored six points out of seven possible and captured 9th place in his division. He received an enormous trophy for his efforts (see photos). Kweilin finished with 5 points (including two draws) and won the under-1400 trophy in the Elementary division. Kweilin finished with the best score of all female participants in the Elementary division (no award was offered for this distinction). The three kids in the Primary section all eked out four points (4-3, no draws). This was the first year of participation for all of these children.

Unfortunately, no Washington school was able to muster enough personnel to compete at the team level. The closest was Broadview Elementary (Oak Harbor) which beat out Sacajawea (Seattle) in the State Championships in March. At least three players from a school were needed to compete as a team. Broadview's top scorer was unable to attend (although his parents were apparently willing to underwrite his participation) due to Little League obligations. It is likely this player would have been able to at least match those participating which would have qualified Broadview for a team trophy. Tournament rules did not allow grouping of players from several schools to form a single team.

Naturally, these children must have done something to

motivate their parents to come up with necessary airfare. Indeed, Kweilin Moore was the Washington State Elementary School Champion, going undefeated in five rounds of tournament play and five rounds of round robin speed chess playoffs. Her brother, Litsun, finished as runner up to the fifth grade champion. Peter McCullum scored 4.5 out of 5 and finished in the top five of the primary section of the State tournament and Paul Doyle finished as runner up to the third grade champion. Julia Neuhaus garnered a total of 4 points and was the second grade state champion, narrowly missing the title of Primary champion by losing to the holder of that title in the final round. Unfortunately, a number of other well qualified children did not participate, either due to other commitments or lack of funding.

# Mountlake Terrace Class

April 22-23, 1989

After the Karpov-Hjartarson Match ended in early February, it seemed to me that players north of Seattle would be ready for a new regional event. I expected about 100 players. All that seemed to remain was to find a site.

The deadline for the first TA in *Chess Life* had already passed and the next was closing when Mountlake Terrace High School chess coach Bill Rasmussen offered the school as a possibility. And so there it was held! The entire chess team received free entries. A chess computer, the "Designer 2100", was ordered from the USCF for delivery to the school. Weather was beautiful and during daylight, the local birds just flew around outside, happily chirping. Plenty of free parking. On a Spring morning, this school has its own special ambiance!

When the April issue of NWC was late, we lost an estimated 20-30 entries, thus causing the bottom line to shift from a reasonable black to several hundred dollars red. And this despite all the advance planning, statewide mailing of 1900 flyers, telephone calls to the editor, etc! If I had only known, I would have planned the mailout on a different schedule. It shows that you cannot be certain of anything and that some percentage of success in any enterprise can be attributed to just plain luck!

Years ago, in 1973 for instance, the gas crisis came along without warning and totally wiped out my "Seattle Chess Facility" at 94th and Aurora, and that despite a promising beginning. (Some of you may still remember that the big TV-covered match that launched Yasser Seirawan on his career began at that site.) In Vietnam in 1966-68, I had been stranded on patrol in VC-controlled territory, my bunk was mortared while I happened not to be in it (due to a last minute change of duty officers that night which put me on another compound). I have been ambushed, shot at by snipers, and came under rocket fire during the TET offensive, but they missed almost every time. *Tell me about luck!*

The Mountlake Terrace Class was, however, an easy and enjoyable event for the tournament staff and the players! There were no complaints or disputes that I was aware of. And I am especially thankful for the help of Bill Rasmussen, John A. Scott and the ubiquitous computer which greatly simplifies the paperwork! Once you have top class helpers and the computer you wonder how you ever got along without them! Russell Miller with the Pioneer West bookshop also added to the friendly atmosphere.

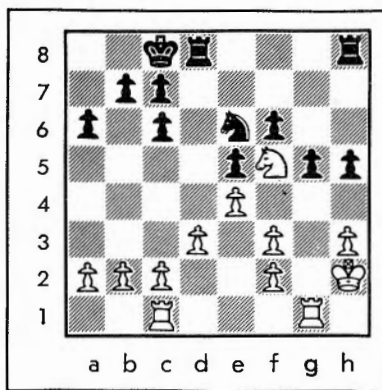

I received 7 calls from interested masters and experts, and I promised the first six that there would be a place reserved for them in the KOM.

We did not want a situation where top ranked players would "hang around" to see if they would be able to enter - similar to the old Alternates Cup for the Washington Closed. My standby plan was to hold KOM-2 with half the prize fund, if additional players 2000 and above had shown up. KOM prizes were not large, but the entry fee structure was such that the players received back DOUBLE what they put in. They also had the measured pace of a round robin, knowing each opponent and their colors in advance. Some grandmasters claim that this format makes them better players than the swiss format.

# Computer Chess

## an occasional column by Raleigh Bellas

Hello, this is my first column for Northwest Chess. I hope you like it and send me lots of fan mail and money (large denominations please). The subject of this column is going to revolve around chess, computers, chess computers, chess programs, how to use your chess computer/program to improve your game. As events unfold I will try to supply various news and tidings from the chess and computer world on how the big boys like Hitech and Deep Thought are doing. I may even throw in a tad of social commentary for good measure.

In this first article I will deal with how chess computers think (and to some extent how computers in general think). I will try to show why they can seem to play real well then suddenly lose some material or get mated after taking a few pawns. I will give a few examples of this. I will also show why computers cannot create a strategic plan, and why (with some recent exceptions) they play endgames so badly.

In future issues I hope to review a few chess computers and programs, hopefully giving you a price/performance breakdown and a few suggestions on how to spend your shekles.

I know the question you are asking yourselves right now. "Does this patzer know anything about computers and chess?" Good Question! To answer I'll say that I was a systems programmer for a company that built control systems for aircraft. I also play in tournaments when I can. I'm sure a lot of you can remember beating me. I have also toyed with the idea of building a chess computer with multiple processors (if any one is interested in this, let me know). Well, enough potatoes, on to the meat.

Computer chess programs use two kinds of "thought" processes, algorithms and heuristics. An algorithm is a set process that produces a result, not always a good result, but a result nonetheless. For instance, humans have a making dinner algorithm. It goes like this; Before dinner you go to the store and look at

all the food. You decide what to buy. You go home and set the oven for 350, etc. The next day you do the same thing. This algorithm insures that you eat dinner every day. In the same way a chess computer will use an algorithm for finding the best move in a chess game. It will begin by looking at all possible moves in a chess game. It will even look at real silly moves. A computer can look at thousands of moves per minute. It will then decide what to play by using a set of simplistic goals. It's goal might be to see if it can snag some of your material, or improve its queen mobility.

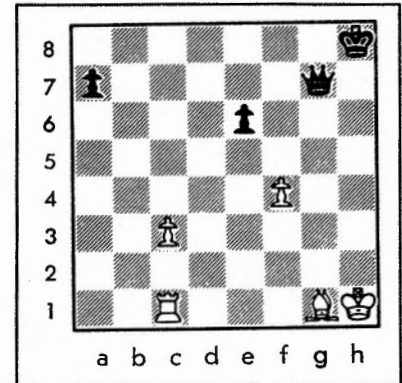
For an experiment and to show a chess computer in the process of using an algorithm, I set up my Chessmaster 2100 program to find a response to 1 e4 with it's opening book program turned off. After about fifteen minutes it had analyzed 170,000 positions to a depth of 5 ply (2.5 chess player moves). At this point it thought that a good line was 1 e4 e5 2 Nc3 Nc6 3 Nf3 Bb4 which it scores as -.25 pawns. After fifteen hours it had analyzed over 9,000,000 positions to a depth of eight ply. It's best line now is 1 e4 Nc6 2 d4 e6 3 Nf3 d5. It still evaluates black as -.25 pawns.

A heuristic is a computer version of the rule of thumb idea. For example a good rule of thumb for spelling is I before E except after C. This is the spelling heuristic for I and E. A chess computer might have a heuristic that does not let it play 1 e4 e5 2 Ke2?? Of course the problem with all rules of thumb is that there are almost always exceptions.

With the help of some good algorithms and heuristics and a really fast search process computers are now starting to play 2300 - 2500 strength. However, since we know how a computer thinks, we can think of ways to out think it.

There are two basic approaches to playing a chess program. The first is a closed game with long range strategic complications (watching out for those tactics). The second is a long range tactics plan that it does not see. (You must plan at least three moves ahead and farther on the advanced levels.)

This is known as the horizon effect. Let me give you an example of the horizon effect that computer programs can fall into.



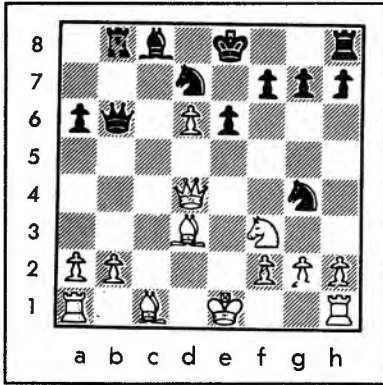
**White to move.** In a one ply search, the computer would think it was winning a pawn by 1 Bxa7. When it looks two ply deep, it notices 1 Bxa7 Qxa7 losing a piece. It also thinks that 1 Bd4 Qxd4 wins a piece for black, and in effect black is winning a pawn by force, since the queen is forking the Bg1 and the Pc3. Not until the three ply level does it realize that 1 Bd4 Qxd4 2 cxd4 wins the queen, and it does not know that the queen is lost by force until it has considered 1 Bd4 e5 2 Bxe5 Qxe5 (or any) 3 fxe5 (or Bxg7). That's 5 ply.

If the computer could give some "spite" checks before the loss of the queen it might not even get around to considering the problem. As long as there is not a forced mate, something is always over the horizon.

One way for a computer to circumvent the horizon effect is to employ "quiescent" search extensions, where all capture and check sequences are carried to a position where no more are possible. This can lead to effective search depths of twelve or more ply, but can also lead to a geometric explosion in its analysis in complex tactical positions.

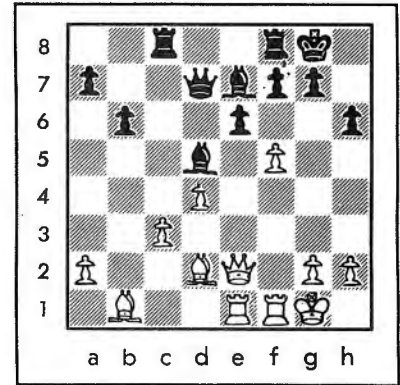

The positions are so wild and unusual that solid positional knowledge is hardly a factor.

Hawkins-MCO suggests 4 a3! c5 5 dxc5 Bxc5 6 c4, a Reversed Queen's Gambit Accepted, with White a move ahead of the normal QGA. White can enter the Queen's Gambit with 4. c4 or 5 c4.

4...c5 5 c3

The Colle. If 5 dx5 White's Bishop should be on e2 in the Reversed QGA because after 5...Bxc5 6 00 Nc6 7 c4? e5 threatens 8...e4.

5...Nc6 6 00 Qc7 7 b3 Bd6 8 Nbd2 e5?!

In general, castling before opening the central files is best, especially if the opponent has already done so.

9 dx5 Nxe5 10 Bc2

Having a slightly worse position, White should simplify with 10 Bb5+, or defend with 10 Be2. Bc2 is thematic in normal lines when ...e5 has not been played.

10...Bg4

Quickly taking advantage of White's last, Black threatens exchanges on f3 winning the h2 pawn.

11 g3??

Weakening the attacked f3, this should lose at once. Hawkins-11 h3 is much better.

11...Nxf3??

Black missed 11...Ne4! 12 Bxe4 dxe4 13 Nxe4 Nxf3+ 14 Kh1 Nxe4. 11...Ne4! attacks the defender of a pinned piece, and is effective because the Knight on f3 cannot be defended again (the King does not count as after ...Nxd2 the Knight is attacked twice). Trying to unpin with 12 h3, in this case loses because 12...Nxc3 deflects the Queen from defending f3 while putting it in a Knight fork: 13 Qe1 Bxf3.

12 Nxf3 h5

Planning to attack the King with ...h4 and ...hgx3. If 13 h4 Bgx3 14 fxx3 Qxx3+ 15 Kh1 Ne4 wins. 13 Kg2 h4 14 h3 Bxf3+ 15 Qxf3 hgx3 15 fxx3 0-0-0 still leaves Black better.

13 Bd3 h4 14 Bb5+ Ke7 15 Qd2??

More resistive is 15 Be2 hgx3 16 hgx3 Bgx3 17 Qd3, but after 17...Bh2+ 18 Kg2 Bh3+ 19 Kh1 Bxf1 20 Bxf1 Ne4! White is lost. Analysis is the most useful skill for chess players. How to analyze is one of the most difficult things to teach. You must learn how far a line must be taken before an accurate evaluation is possible. Candidate moves must be selected for a reason, not at random. Positional weaknesses are relative to the opponent's ability to exploit them, and material, space and time must all be considered holistically.

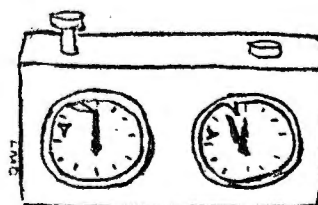
**Position 2**



The final position was inspired by a game 10 years ago, Chun vs Heys. The result of the game was a draw, but afterwards there was a difference of opinion about the objective evaluation of the position. At the University of Washington Chess Club, similar positions were analyzed and played at fast time controls. Yasser Seirawan looked at it briefly and thought it was a draw. John Donaldson felt it must be a win, and was unimpressed by the tricks and traps. No final word was spoken at the time.

Fred Kleist:

The 1989 Paul Keres Memorial Tournament was held on May 19-22 at the Robson Square Media Centre in downtown Vancouver. Despite the large turnout of Washington and Oregon players (seven in the Open section, 12 in the Intermediate, and three in the Amateur) attendance was less than the expected 175.

The U.S. contingent put in a solid performance with 14 players getting an even score or better. Marvin Hayami took clear first in the Intermediate section with a score of 5.5-0.5. Brendon Gehring, the sole leader going into the last round lost to Hayami, but tied for first-second Under 1800. Other Northwest players achieving a plus score were Tony Ciano (3.5-2.5), who was ill throughout the tournament, Ben Delson (4-2), who lost his first two games before adjusting to the longer (40/120 vs 40/90) time control, and Mike Vaughn (3.5-2.5), who said that he will do much better in the National Open.

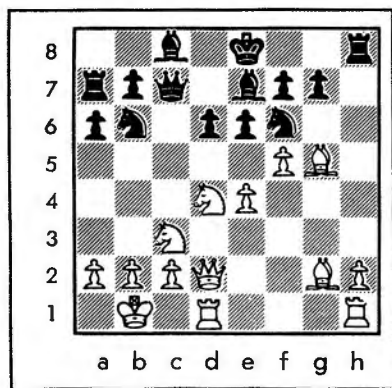
In the Amateur section Mykal Egbert, a Last Exit habitue playing as an unrated, held a share of the lead going into Monday, but faltered in the fifth round and finished a half point off the pace as 5-1 took both the place prizes and a share of the unrated prize. Had he been eligible for the Under 1400 prize, he would have taken it with a point to spare.

Many will return next year. Thanks to Jeremy Crowhurst, Henry Chiu, and Lynn Stringer for directing the tournament.

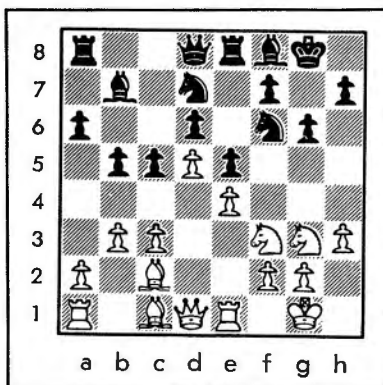

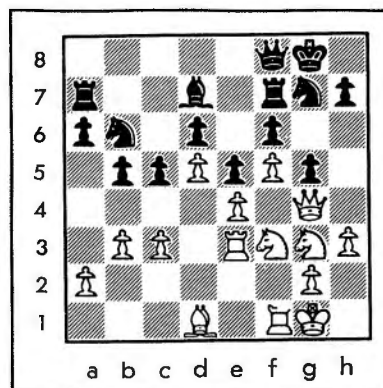
